

## **ADDENDUM #2**

RFA-2023-BEAS-07-TRANS

Transportation Services (Changes are in **bold, underlined and italicized text** below to enable vendors

to quickly recognize changes in paragraphs and/or wording.)

On August 3, 2022, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Application, to solicit applications from community-based organizations to support older adult and disability populations throughout New Hampshire by providing transportation services to and/or from an individual's home to a specific destination, including but not limited to medical/dental appointments, shopping, social events, community dining/congregate meals, and volunteer opportunities.

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

- 1. Modify Section 1, Subsection 1.2, Scope of Services, Paragraph 1.2.9, to read as follows:
  - 1.2.9 The selected Applicant must provide (*written*) notice of eligibility or non-eligibility to individuals and provide services to eligible individuals for the one-year eligibility period as required by New Hampshire Administrative Rule He-E 502.
- 2. Modify Section 1, Subsection 1.2, Scope of Services, Paragraph 1.2.10, to delete the text in its entirety to read as follows:
  - 1.2.10. Reserved.
- 3. Modify Section 1, Subsection 1.2, Scope of Services, Paragraph 1.2.20, to read as follows:
  - 1.2.20 The selected Applicant must continue to provide services to APS (without requesting a donation) for up to one (1) calendar year after APS closes the case when a determination is made that the client needs services to help prevent decline and re-involvement with APS.
