

ADDENDUM #1

RFA-2023-DPHS-05-COVID COVID-19 Testing and Vaccination Services

On July 28, 2022, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for COVID-19 Testing and Vaccination Services, soliciting applications from qualified Vendor(s) to provide COVID-19 testing, CoOVID-19 vaccines, or other vaccines as directed by the Department, which includes but is not limited to:

- A minimum of three (3) mobile vaccination teams.
- One (1) COVID-19 public health services team to provide COVID-19 testing, COVID-19 vaccine, or other vaccines as directed by the Department to homebased individuals.
- Scheduling and coordinating COVID-19 testing and vaccination services.

From the date of release of this solicitation until an award is made and announced regarding the selection of a Vendor, all communication with personnel employed by or under contract with the Department regarding this solicitation is prohibited unless first approved by the Point of Contact listed above. Department employees have been directed not to hold conferences and/or discussions concerning this solicitation with any potential contractor during the selection process, unless otherwise authorized by the Point of Contact. Vendors may be disqualified for violating this restriction on communications.

- 2. Modify Section 2. Statement of Work, Subsection 2.1, Scope of Services COVID-19 Mobile Testing & Vaccination Clinics, Paragraph 2.1.1., to read:
 - 2.1.1. The selected Vendor(s) must provide a minimum of three (3) mobile teams, seven days a week for 10 hours per day, as directed by the Department,



the Department will provide 48 hour notice of location requirements, to administer COVID-19 services which must include:

- 2.1.1.1. COVID-19 testing, <u>approximately 500 test per month across all 3</u> <u>mobile vans and 1 homebased van</u>:
 - 2.1.1.1.1. Point-of-care antigen tests.
 - 2.1.1.1.2. Laboratory Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests.
 - 2.1.1.2. COVID-19 vaccinations, <u>capacity to perform up to 4,200 vaccine</u> <u>administrations per week across all 3 mobile vans</u>:
 - 2.1.1.2.1. Primary series.
 - 2.1.1.2.2. Additional doses.
 - 2.1.1.2.3. Booster doses to all eligible vaccine recipients in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, and as directed by the Department.
 - 2.1.1.2.4. Other vaccines at the direction of the Department

3. Modify Section 2. Statement of Work, Subsection 2.2, Scope of Services – Homebased COVID-19 Services, Paragraph 2.2.1., to read:

- 2.2.1 The selected Vendor(s) must provide a minimum of one (1) mobile COVID-19 services team, <u>seven days a week for 10 hours per day, as directed by</u> <u>the Department, the Department will provide 48 hour notice of location</u> <u>requirements</u>, to administer COVID-19 services which must include:
 - 2.2.1.1. COVID-19 testing, *approximately 500 test per month across all 3 mobile vans and 1 homebased van*:
 - 2.2.1.1.1. Point-of-care antigen tests.
 - 2.2.1.1.2. Laboratory Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests.
 - 2.2.1.2. COVID-19 vaccinations, <u>capacity to perform up to 420 vaccine</u> <u>administrations per week</u>:
 - 2.2.1.2.1. Primary series.
 - 2.2.1.2.2. Additional doses.
 - 2.2.1.2.3. Booster doses to all eligible vaccine recipients in accordance with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, and as directed by the Department.
 - 2.2.1.2.4. Other vaccines at the direction of the Department



- 4. Modify Section 2. Statement of Work, Subsection 2.2, Scope of Services Homebased COVID-19 Services, Paragraph 2.2.6., to read:
 - 2.2.6. A healthcare practitioner, defined as either a Physician (MD/DO), Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN), or Physician's Assistant (PA), must be available for telehealth consultation during mobile testing operations <u>and</u> <u>must be available to be onsite as requested by the Department, within 48 hours notice.</u>

**The monthly cost is based on 2,500 vaccinations for 3 mobile testing vaccination vans(Section 2.1) and scope in Section 2.3, if the selected vendor exceeds >2,500 vaccinations in a month, the vaccine (per dose) payment can be billed per vaccine administered.

***The monthly cost is based on 500 vaccinations for 1 homebased van (Section 2.2) and scope in Section 2.3, if the selected vendor exceeds >500 vaccinations in a month, the vaccine (per dose) payment can be billed per vaccine administered.



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
