Youth						603-540-0810		Services Provided: <b>Straw Hatman Program</b> (Ages 18-25* birthday) provides basic needs assistance, assessment, intensive case management, and connection to community resources (We do not provide emergency shelter for youth over 18) <b>Youth Resource Center Drop-in Center</b> (Ages 12-25* birthday) located at 298 Hanover Street, Manchester- Access to food pantry, clothing closet, shower, laundry facilities, and intensive case management. 9am-7pm 7 days a week. <b>Rainbow and Rainbow Youth Program</b> (Ages 12-17) provides basic needs, assessment, family mediation, case management, and emergency housing (We only provide emergency housing options to youth 12-17) <b>Transitional Living Program</b> (Ages 18-21 upon entry) - Provides safe housing, intensive case management, life skills building (This is not emergency shelter. There is an assessment process.) <b>Young Adult Low Barrier Emergency Shelter</b> : Located at 298 Hanover Street Manchester. This shelter is a 14 bed low barrier shelter which serves young adults 18-24 years of age. Young adults need to be on the shelter list before 5pm and are not guaranteed a spot as space is pulled nightly.
