Transactions include all EVV data activity within or interfaced with the Vendor's system. Data cannot be modified undetectably. In addition, data needs to be sent and received with guaranteed delivery regardless of the interface mode (e.g., API or batch). See Addendum #4.

In accordance with 42 CFR 431.200, "This subpart {42 CFR 431.206} implements section 1902(a)(3) of the Act, which requires that a State plan provide an opportunity for a fair hearing to any person whose claim for assistance is denied or not acted upon promptly. This subpart also prescribes procedures for an opportunity for hearing if the Medicaid agency takes action to suspend, terminate, or reduce services." The relevant application is how EVV may affect services for individuals.
