The selected Vendor must conduct 30 or more trainings that cover all topics outlined. The vendor must propose how many trainings it will take to cover all the topics. For example, a training on all 13 topics may take 2-3 days and the selected Vendor would conduct the training 30+ times.
2.	Section 3, Statement of Work, Subsection 3.1, Covered Populations Does the Department envision the same quantity of training for all approximately 3,450 people?	Yes.
