1.	<b>General</b> What is the funding amount?	Vendors must propose total costs to deliver services. See Section 4.2. Budget, Staff List and Budget Narrative.
2.	<b>General</b> Will the Department consider extending the submission deadline for proposals?	Not at this time. Please see <b>Section 6.2</b> . <b>Procurement Timetable</b> for the submission deadline. If the Department decides to extend the deadline, an addendum will be posted on the DHHS website.
3.	Section 3. Statement of Work, Subsection 3.2. Scope of Services, Subparagraphs 3.2.1. through 3.2.3. Subparagraph 3.2.1. requires the vendor to develop a statewide program to connect individuals with local or statewide services; Subparagraph 3.2.2. specifies that the vendor must provide telephone and online activities; and Subparagraph 3.2.3. specifies that the vendor must collaborate with community partners to create a library of services. Would you please clarify if the vendor will be expected to create new services as well as market, promote, connect, and create a library of resources developed by other providers?	Please see Subsection 3.2. Scope of Services, Subparagraphs 3.2.1. through 3.2.3. Vendors are asked to propose programming that will decrease feelings of social isolation and increase mental, emotional and physical well-being of the population served, which may include new and current services. Vendors must collaborate with community partners to develop a library of available activities, programs and services, and vendors must market activities, programs and services available.



4	Section 3. Statement of Work, Subsection 3.2. Scope of Services, Subparagraph 3.2.2. Subparagraph 3.2.2. states that "the selected Vendor must provide telephone and online activities, education, and/or an assortment of support groups for older adults, from the comfort of their home." Why was the RFP limited to only in-home supports?	Please see <b>Subsection 1.1. Purpose and Overview.</b> The services in this RFP are intended to support older individuals, experiencing isolation, to be able to access services from their home.
