

ADDENDUM #1

Supported Housing for Adults Transitioning To or From Glencliff Home (Changes are in **bold, underlined and italicized text** below to enable vendors to quickly recognize changes in paragraphs and/or wording.)

On November 14, 2022, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, soliciting qualified Vendors to provide supportive housing for adults who are transitioning from or awaiting admission to Glencliff Home; have a severe mental illness (SMI) or severe and persistent mental illness (SPMI); and may also have co-occurring intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD), acquired brain disorders, or complex medical needs.

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

1. Modify Section 1, Purpose and Overview, Subsection 1.1., Introduction, with the following:

The New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services, Division for Behavioral Health ("Department") is seeking responses to this Request for Proposals ("solicitation" or "RFP") from qualified Vendors to provide supportive housing for adults who are transitioning from or awaiting admission to Glencliff Home; have a severe mental illness (SMI) or severe and persistent mental illness (SPMI); and may also have co-occurring intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD), acquired brain disorders, or complex medical needs.

The Department anticipates awarding one (1) or more contracts for the services in this solicitation, for a total of up to 18 beds. <u>Vendors must submit one (1) proposal that describes comprehensive service provision for one (1) or more sites, as defined in this RFP.</u>

- 2. Modify Section 2. Statement of Work, Subsection 2.1. Scope of Services, Paragraph 2.1.17. with the following:
 - 2.1.17 The selected Vendor(s) must ensure all background checks are conducted in compliance with New Hampshire Administrative Rule <u>He-M 1002.03 (h)</u> <u>through (o).</u>
