## Effective Practices for the Treatment of Opioid and Stimulant Use Disorders

On December 6, 2022, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, soliciting proposals from qualified Vendors for the development and implementation of a behavioral-based intervention Contingency Management program for individuals receiving outpatient treatment for Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) or Stimulant Use Disorders (StimUD).

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

- 1. Modify Section 2, Statement of Work, Subsection 2.1, Scope of Services, Paragraph 2.1.1, by adding Subparagraph 2.1.1.7. to read:
  - 2.1.1.7. Complies with Grant funding requirements to ensure the value of each contingency, earned per individual, must not exceed \$15 per instance and the total contingency amount per individual must not exceed \$75 per year.
