On May 10, 2022, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, to solicit proposals for the provision of a consulting firm to conduct a comprehensive evaluation of the Department's Medicaid Care Management (MCM) model and other complementary health and human services within the Department. The goals of the resulting contract include evaluating the performance of the current MCM model in meeting the physical, behavioral, and human service needs of the population and identifying additional models that may optimize the delivery of services and improve outcomes for those served.

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

- 1. Delete and replace Section 3, Statement of Work, Subsection 3.2 Sample Evaluation Presentation, Paragraph 3.2.1., with the following:
 - 3.2.1. The Department will score the answers to the Technical Proposal, as described in Section 5.2.1 through 5.2.5 prior to the Sample Evaluation Presentations. The Department will only invite Vendor(s) with the top three (3) technical scores (out of 700 points) to participate in a mandatory Sample Evaluation Presentation, which will be scored based on 175 points. In the event of a tie, the Department will invite additional parties.
