

ADDENDUM #3

RFP-2024-DLTSS-01-HEALT Health Care Coordination for Children with Special Health Care Needs (Changes are in <u>bold, underlined and italicized text</u> below to enable vendors to quickly recognize changes in paragraphs and/or wording.)

On March 6, 2023, the New Hampshire Department of Health and Human Services published a Request for Proposals, to enhance the system of care with community-based,

family centered care coordination for children with special healthcare needs (CSHCN), birth to twenty-one (21) years of age, and their families.

The Department is publishing this addendum to:

- 1. Modify Section 2, Scope of Work, Subsection 2.1, Scope of Services, Paragraph 2.1.11, Domain 5: Care Coordination Workforce, Subparagraph 2.1.11.1, Article 2.1.11.1.1, to read:
 - 2.1.11.1.1. The selected Vendor(s) must make a request in writing to the Department before hiring new program personnel who do not meet the following required staff qualifications. The Department may approve a waiver based on the needs of the program and/or the individual's experience and education.
 - 2.1.11.1.1.1 A Bachelor's degree; and
 - 2.1.11.1.2 Two (2) years of experience in care coordination or within community programs serving CSHCN or four (4) years of experience working with children and families.
